MANAGEMENT IN THE DIGITAL ERA: CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

Prof. dr. Florina PINZARU

National University of Political Studies and Public Administration, Faculty of Management, Bucharest, Romania

The concept of the digital economy is not new, however, in the past couple of years it captured the attention of academics, researchers, and professionals, since the digitization process, once specific just to the IT&C sector, started to dramatically re-frame the entire economy as we know it. The digital revolution shapes the business environment as we know it: we see companies make use of the AI platforms such as the IBM's Watson for diagnosing cancer, or of the automotive robotics; we see companies use data in order to predict their customer's needs or understand their behavior; we see new business models emerging or new products or services. The business environment is changing, and all these new technologies help companies navigate the intricate consumer and employees' expectations.

Florina Pinzaru's speech on the specificity of management in the digital era will cover aspects such as: the profile of the digital consumers and the impact on business strategies; the rise of the Millenials and of the Generation Z at work; the challenges of the sharing economy; how to manage in a world where business models change rapidly under the influence of the digital transformation.

DIGITAL MARKETING AND THE NEW-NORMAL BUSINESS: OPPORTUNITIES AND CHALLENGES

Digital marketing has always evolved as a critical business function, especially in the wake of major global events. It evolved to help businesses to adapt, survive, and thrive. Therefore, visionary new-normal businesses will have to rely on revised digital marketing



strategies and tools to address the current global and local challenges. Challenges such changing consumers' attitudes, decreasing discretionary incomes, a fluid workforce, an increasing reliance on automation and data, and daunting security challenges put businesses and consumers in a radically new environment. Yet, digital marketing could offer opportunities to both businesses and consumers. Specifically, using artificial intelligence to uncover new market segments, the reconstruction of products, services, and rewards programs in the digital space, or the emergence of new distribution models could address many uncertainties. Against this backdrop, Cristian's presentation extends an open invitation to a broad discussion of the role of digital marketing in the new-normal business.
